Subject: Restoration of halts of 10105/10106 Sawantwadi ↔ Diva Express as travel time has not

reduced after dropping many halts

Respected Sir,

The Ministry of Railways converted the 50105/50106 Sawantwadi Diva Passenger train into an Express service in 2020 as a part of Zero Based Time Table activity. Central Railway removed 11 intermediate stops, and Konkan Railway removed 7 stops to achieve this, resulting in a total reduction of 18 halts. This significant reduction in stops was expected to yield time savings of at least 100 minutes. Both the Ministry of Railways and the Railway Board had promised a reduction in travel time as a result of these changes. However, despite these efforts, the travel time for the train remains nearly the same as per the schedule and, in some cases, has even increased during its actual runs. Central Railway's decision to provide stoppages at Apta and Jite instead of Pen and Nagothane is a topic of research.

The Zero Based Time Table activity, in retrospect, has not yielded the anticipated benefits for any region, as the railway department has begun to reverse some of the decisions made during this exercise. This reversal has come in response to criticism from stakeholders, particularly passengers.

We kindly request that you follow up with the Ministry of Railways to consider reinstating the halts for the

10105/10106 Sawantwadi ↔ Diva train at various stations, including Kolad, Indapur, Diwankhavti, Anjani, Kamthe, Ukshi, and Bhoke on the Konkan Railway route, as well as Pen and Nagothane on the Central Railway route. Furthermore, we would like to propose the addition of new halts at Kalambani Budruk and Kadvai along the Konkan Railway route to enhance connectivity and convenience for passengers.
